Robert Home MA (Cantab), PhD (LSE), MRTPI, is Emeritus Professor in Land Management at Anglia Ruskin University (UK). He has researched, travelled and published extensively on planning and land in Africa. His latest publications include 'Climate change law and policy in the MENA region' (chapter, 2020) and 'Urban land issues for Urban governance in Sub-Saharan Africa' (Springer 2020). Previously, Rob was Reader in Planning at University of East London, and Lecturer in the Department of Land Management & Development at the University of Reading. He has held visiting positions at the Universities of Onati (Spain), Stellenbosch & Pretoria (South Africa), Ife (Nigeria), Copperbelt (Zambia), Haifa (Israel), Kyoto (Japan), and Hong Kong.

The presentation will focus particularly on SDG 11 on cities, the New Urban Agenda (2015), their application to Africa, and how targets and indicators can be measured.
