Santander International Scholarships

The University of Lincoln is proud to be among more than 1,200 higher education institutions around the world who are part of the Santander Universities network. As a member, the University of Lincoln in conjunction with Santander Bank, are delighted to offer a range of funding for projects and initiatives including international scholarships, mobility awards and research grants.

The University of Lincoln International Office are delighted to award four Santander International Scholarships to high achieving students from select countries. For 2019, the scholarships are designed to reward applicants who demonstrate high standards of academic excellence alongside personal and extracurricular endeavour.

For programmes commencing in February and September 2019, scholarship applications are invited from high achieving students from the following countries: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, China, Colombia, Ghana, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Qatar, Russia, Singapore, United Arab Emirates, Uruguay and the USA.

The Santander International Scholarship is valued at £5,000 which will be deducted from tuition fees during the first year of enrolment.

The Application Process

In order to apply for this scholarship, prospective students must meet the following criteria:

- Be a national of (or permanently domiciled in) one of the following countries: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, China, Colombia, Ghana, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Qatar, Russia, Singapore, United Arab Emirates, Uruguay or the USA.
- Already hold a Conditional or Unconditional Offer from the University of Lincoln for a full time undergraduate or postgraduate taught course of study commencing in September 2019
- Meet the English language requirements of their intended course of study – this typically ranges from IELTS 6.0 – 7.0 or equivalent
- Be able to meet any UK Tier 4 visa requirements

Please note that this scholarship is competitive and will only be awarded to candidates with the highest academic qualifications / demonstration of personal and extracurricular endeavour.

In addition to meeting the above residency, academic and English language requirements, candidates must complete the attached application form and submit this to intscholarships@lincoln.ac.uk. It is important that we receive your application by 4pm (UK time) on one of the following dates:

For courses commencing in February 2019

Monday 19th November 2018

For courses commencing in September 2019

Friday 31st May 2019

Upon close of the scholarship deadline, a panel will meet to assess each scholarship application carefully and will endeavour to notify all candidates of a decision within 10 days of the application closing date.

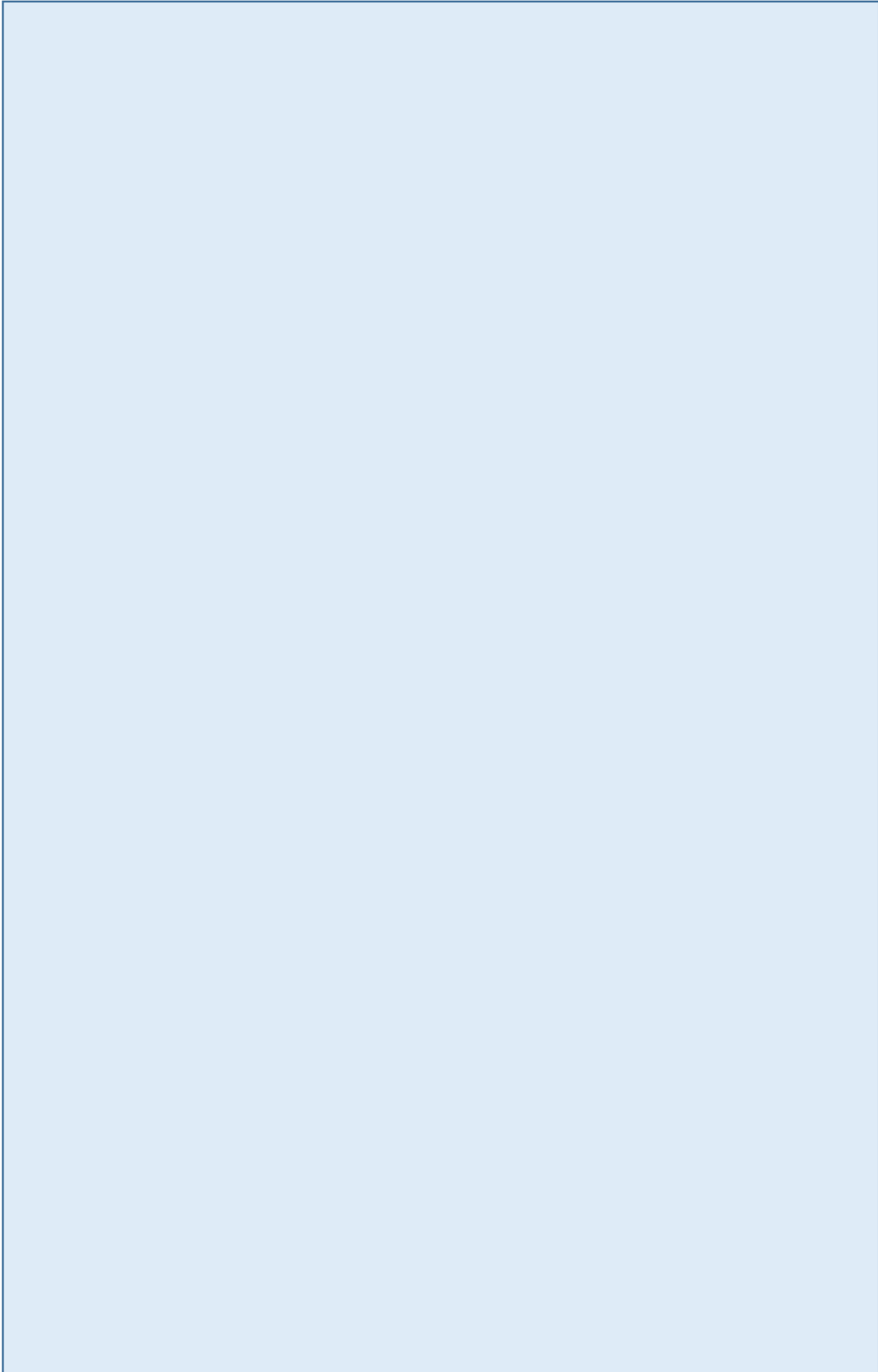

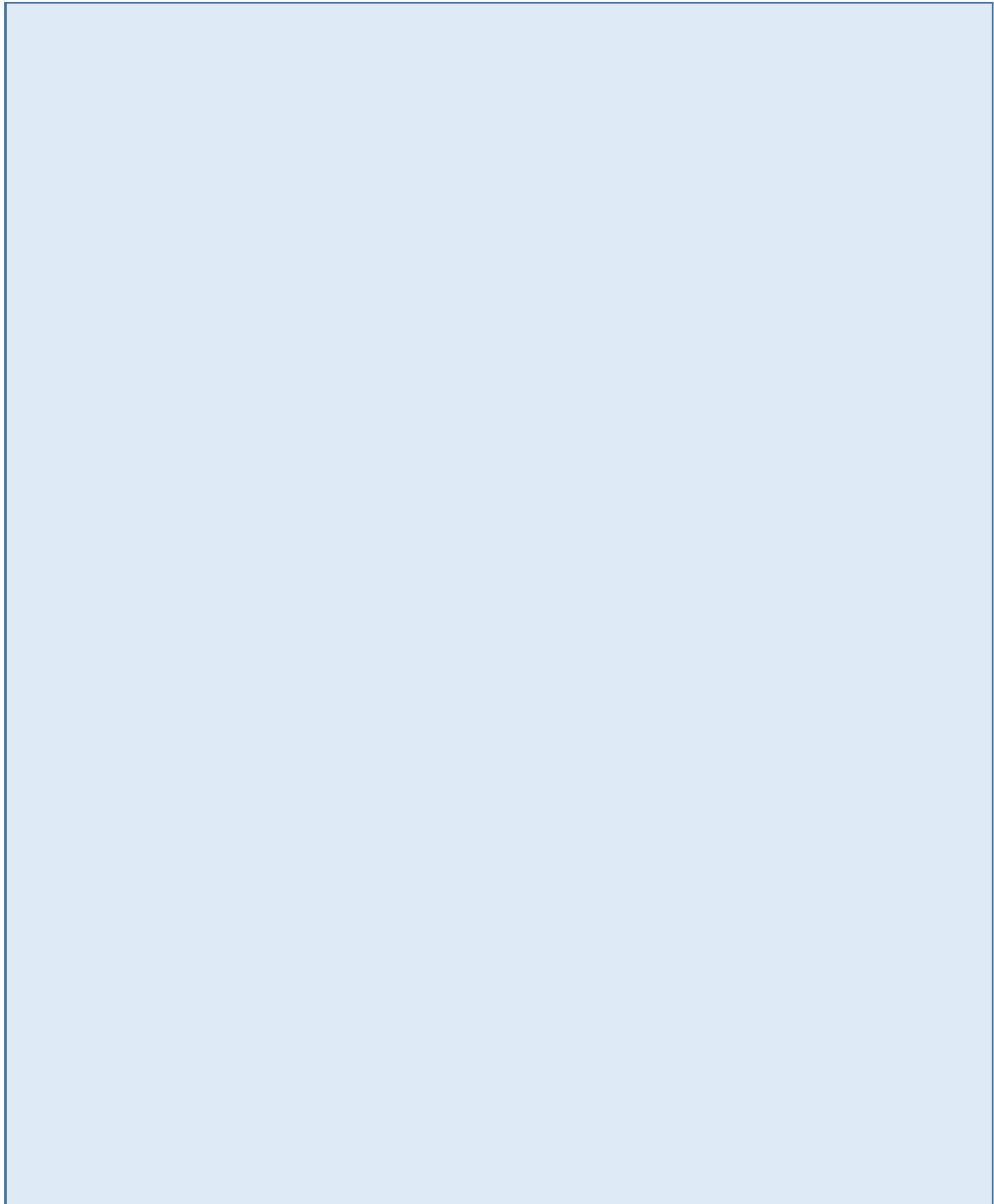
You are required to write a 400 word statement which demonstrates your current and future potential for excellence in both academia and personal endeavour. As part of your answer, you may wish to consider the following topics:

International Scholarships Terms and Conditions 2019

For the purposes of this document, the following definitions shall apply:

Definition of ‘International Student’

An international fee paying student with overseas fee status.

Definition of ‘Degree Programme’

A credit bearing undergraduate or postgraduate course of study at the University of Lincoln.

General Terms and Conditions

1. University of Lincoln International Scholarships take the form of a tuition fee reduction upon enrolment. No cash alternative is available.
2. University of Lincoln International Scholarships are non-transferable and are not valid in conjunction with each other; only one Scholarship per student per course will be applied.
3. The University of Lincoln reserves the right to withdraw any University of Lincoln International Scholarship at any point and without notice.
4. Students who are sponsored by an organisation such as an external funding body, Government, or employer are not eligible to receive a University of Lincoln International Scholarship.

Additional Terms and Conditions applying to Santander International Scholarships

5. To be eligible for the Santander International Scholarship, scholarship applicants must be a national of (or permanently domiciled in) one of the following countries covered by the Santander Universities Global Division scheme: Argentina, Brazil, Chile, China, Colombia, Ghana, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Qatar, Russia, Singapore, Unites Arab Emirates, Uruguay, and the USA.
6. The scholarship is only applicable to International Students joining the first year of a University of Lincoln Undergraduate or Postgraduate Taught / Masters by Research Degree Programme.
7. Candidates must already hold a Conditional or Unconditional Offer from the University of Lincoln for an eligible full time Undergraduate or Postgraduate Taught / Masters by Research Degree Programme commencing in 2019.
8. Candidates must complete and submit a Santander International Scholarship Application Form no later than 4pm (UK time) on Friday 31 May 2019. Applications received after this deadline will not be considered.
9. The scholarships will be awarded for one year only.
